NESBC Rules

I. General

- a. All riders must be entered in the Penguin track day or racer practice the day of the event
- b. All currently non-licensed riders must complete Penguin NESBC or Basic course before their first event (can be completed that morning).

II. Team Structure

- a. Teams will consist of a maximum of 4 riders plus one optional Expert "Mentor".
 - i. "Mentors" are designated coaches for a team. Mentors may be included in the 4 rider roster or may be added as a non-riding team member.
- b. Once the opening event in June has finished, all Team Rosters that have been submitted are considered final.
- c. Once a rider has been assigned to a Team, that rider must remain on that team for the duration of the 2017 season.
- d. Teams are allowed one Team Rider change per season.
- e. There is no time limitation for the submission of a new Team Roster.

III. Classes

a. Street Bike 1 & 2 – Track Day Riders

- i. Riders must have never held a road race license
- ii. Penguin reserves the right to advance any rider outside the spirit of this class
- iii. **Street Bike 1** – All Middleweight and larger machines

Single cylinder, unlimited displacement

Two stroke, liquid cooled, pre-1985 model year, up to 750cc

Two stroke, liquid cooled, street production models, up to 515cc

Two stroke, air cooled, unlimited displacement

Twin cylinder, air-cooled, unlimited displacement

Twin cylinder, 2 or 3 valves per cylinder, unlimited displacement

Twin cylinder, 4 valve per cylinder, up to 855cc

Three cylinder, up to 1000cc

Four cylinder, liquid cooled, up to 650cc

Four cylinder, air cooled, 2 valve, up to 1200cc

Street Bike 2 – All Lightweight machines

Single cylinder, unlimited displacement

Two stroke, liquid cooled, up to 450cc

Two stroke, air cooled, unlimited displacement

Twin cylinder, air cooled, up to 1210cc

Twin cylinder, liquid cooled, non-desmodromic valves, up to 800cc

Four cylinder, liquid cooled, up to 565cc

Four cylinder, air cooled, 2 valve, up to 750cc

- b. Intermediate A & B – Highly experienced Track day, Novice & qualifying Amateur racers
 - i. Riders must either be non-licensed or LRRS Novice licensed riders.
 - ii. Street Bike Class Riders may be advanced to Novice at the discretion of Penguin
 - iii. Amateur racers – all Amateur riders are welcome. Riders who have reached the following milestones in their riding career must be pre-approved for this class
 - 1. Top 3 finishers in NESBC Formula 300 or Motard Races
 - 2. LRRS Amateur race winners or class champions
 - iv. Former Expert Riders – must be pre-approved by Penguin must not have held a road racing license since 2000
 - v. Former regional Expert Champions/AMA Pro Riders – not allowed
 - vi. Penguin reserves the right to exclude any rider outside the spirit of the class
 - vii. Novice A displacement limits – see Street Bike 1
 - viii. Novice B displacement limits – see Street Bike 2

- c. Purse Paying Classes - Motard & Formula 300
 - i. No license restrictions, open to all riders up to a Pro level
 - ii. Motard Rules – see LRRS Motard Class
 - iii. Formula 300 Rules – see LRRS Formula 300 rules.
